## Constitution Day at Navy Children School, Kochi

Navy Children School, Kochi celebrated 'Constitution Day' or 'Samvidhan Divas' on the 26<sup>th</sup> of December 2019 to commemorate adoption of the Indian Constitution in 1949. Students put up a conundrum of events to endorse the spirit of the day.



The celebrations commenced with the morning assembly followed by a Reading of the Preamble by Anusree of Class XII and thereafter an appraisal of Fundamental Duties by Avani also of Class XII.
