1. <u>**Courses**</u>. Undergraduate programmes in Engineering/ Natural Sciences/ Management & Entrepreneurship/ Humanities & Social Sciences. Details of programmes/ subjects can be accessed from the University website www.snuadmissions.com.

2. Fee Concession/ Reservation of Seats for Naval Wards.

(a) Concession in Tuition fees to the extent of **100%** (Freeship) for upto 2 wards of naval personnel died in harness.

(b) Concession in Tuition fees to the extent of **75% for upto 3 wards of serving naval personnel**.

(c) Concession in Tuition fees to the extent of **50% for upto 3 wards of retired naval personnel**.

***Note**. Students would be required to pay accommodation/ food charges and any other fee as applicable.

Selection Procedure

The concessions mentioned above shall be awarded to students who are 3. shortlisted after completing the admission process (including eligibility required for a particular program) of the University for the specific Admissions year. 3. Wards of *IN* personnel desirous of availing the above concessions are to complete the due procedure as laid down by the University for registration and obtain confirmation of admission. The extant procedure for registration/ admissions at FLAME University is as follows:-

(a) Students need to register themselves by paying a non-refundable fee of Rs 2,000/- (or as prescribed by the University from time to time), on the FLAME University website **www.flame.edu.in**

(b) After registration, students are to fill in personal/ academic particulars and upload photographs and academic and extra-curricular certificates.

(c) Students need to answer three questions under the Statement of Purpose (SOP) category.

(d) After filling up the application, uploading of documents and answering SOP questions, candidates will receive an email from the University intimating the schedule of the entrance test - FLAME Entrance Aptitude Test (FEAT). FEAT is a 120 min online exam in which 100 min will be towards objective part (Verbal Reasoning, Logical Reasoning, Basic Mathematics and General Knowledge) and 20 min for Essay.

(e) Post completion of FEAT, students will receive an email from the University for an interview, which is also conducted online.

(f) Selected students will receive an offer letter by email, about 15 days after the interview.

(g) <u>Eligibility criteria</u>. Minimum 50% in class 12 for Under Graduate programme. However, students can apply with their Class 10 and Class 11 marks for the UG programme as the results of class 12 would not be available during application.

The application should reach NWWA Central Office, New Delhi within ten days of declaration of results of last admission cycle by FLAME University. DNE would in turn forward the list of selected candidates to FLAME University within ten days of last date for submission of applications.

(b) The application should reach NWWA Central Office, New Delhi (by email to nwwacentral@gmail.com) by 31 May or within ten days of release of offer letters for the last round of admissions by the University/ Institution (wherever applicable); whichever is later.
